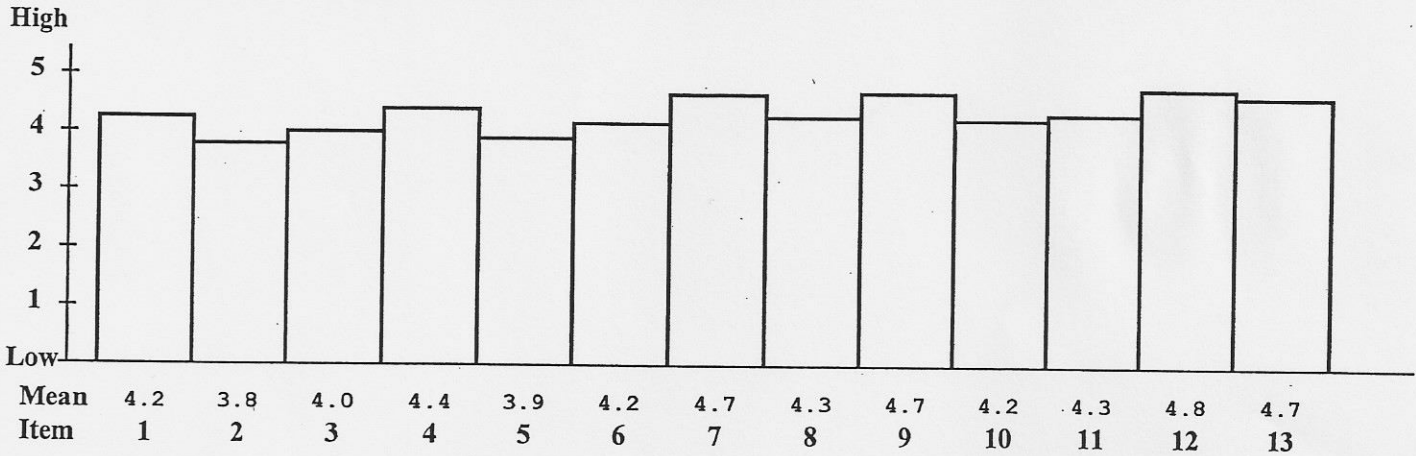

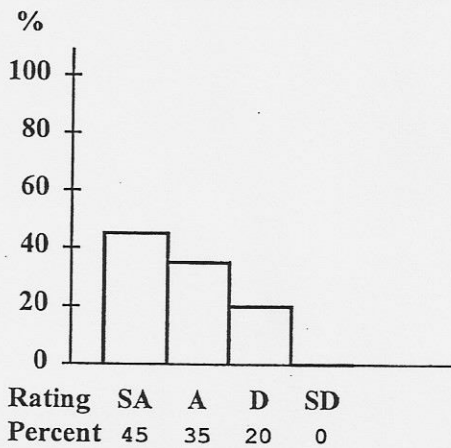

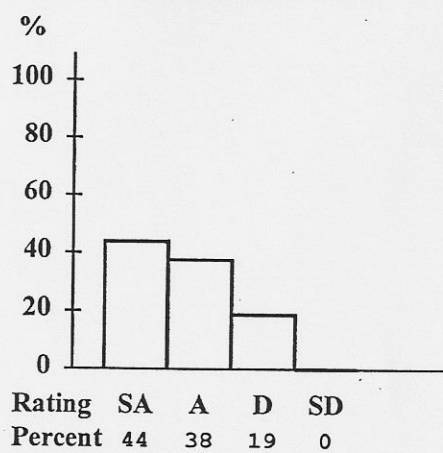
Section II Graphic Representation of Means of Items in Section II



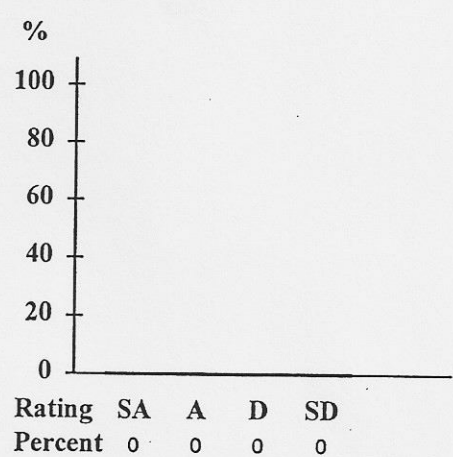
Section I Consumer Information Item 3: Overall Teaching Effectiveness
